COMPETITION INFORMATION

The 13th Annual Colorado High School Team Figure Skating Championships, sponsored by the Denver Figure Skating Club (DFSC), will be held Saturday, April 18th, 2010 at the South Suburban Ice Arena, 6580 South Vine Street, Centennial, Colorado.

The Competition will be conducted in accordance with the rules as stated in the 2010-2011 USFS Rulebook Part Two, Rules 1040-1041 under "Special Competitions." This announcement will take precedence if there is a conflict with the USFS Rulebook. This competition will use the 6.0 system of judging. All skaters must be registered members with USFS or ISI.

The Competition Committee reserves the right to limit the number of entries, eliminate events due to insufficient entries, and combine or divide groups as necessary.

DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION: Entries must be received by March 20, 2010

FEES: \$60.00 per skater for freeskate/dance, \$20.00 per skater each element (spins & maneuvers), maximum \$40.00 for each event (spins & maneuvers).

REFUNDS: As stated rule #3233 & #3235 page 496 current USFS Rule Book there will be no refunds of any entry fees for any reason including medical.

TEST & AGE: The skater's age as of the competition start date (April 18, 2010) shall govern in all matters dealing with age. Event eligibility is based on the test status (USFS or ISI) as of the competition start date (April 18th, 2010). Skaters may not skate below their USFS or ISI test level, but may skate one level higher. However, freeskate and team events must be skated at the same level.

SCHOOL CRITERIA: All skaters must currently attend a high school or school district either public or private or are home schooled as a student in grades 9-12. This competition is open to schools from states other than Colorado. Each team is limited to a maximum of 5 skaters and can compete with a minimum of 1 skater. A school district may also form a team from high schools within the same district up to the maximum number of skaters allowed, as well as private schools may form a team with other private schools up to the maximum number of skaters allowed. It is recommended that each team forms a team within your own school first, and within your district 2nd. Males and females will skate on the same team.

MUSIC: CDs only, marked with skater's name & team name. All music for freestyle events may have lyrics.

SCHEDULE: To receive a schedule, the team representative must enclose a stamped, self-addressed envelope. As soon as the schedule is complete, the team representative will be notified by mail of the events and times for which your team has entered. Also, please check the Denver Figure Skating website www.denverfsc.org after March 20, 2010 for competition information.

ADMISSION: Free

FACILITY: South Suburban Ice Arena (SSIA) has two indoor surfaces, 85' x 200', with rounded corners. The competition will run on the North Rink. A snack bar will be available and both ice surfaces have spectator seating.

LIABILITY: Skaters, parents, and coaches are encouraged to read Part Two, rule 3222 of the USFS Rule Book regarding club, facility, and USFS liability. Your signature on the entry form will indicate that you have read this section.

Please enclose a stamped legal size envelope addressed with the team representative name and address with your entry.

There will be a \$25.00 service charge for any returned check. Payments by money order or cash will be required in these cases. Skaters will NOT be allowed to compete until all debts are satisfied. Any mail requiring a signature will not be collected and will be returned to the sender. Please do not send entries registered or certified mail.

AWARDS

1. Will be presented to individual skaters in first, second and third place for each freeskate and dance level.
2. Will be presented to the first place team in each event - freeskate, dance, spins, and maneuvers.
3. Will be presented to the first, second, and third place teams with the most overall accumulated points for all events combined.
4. A team sportsmanship award will go to the team receiving the most votes from all the competing teams. Every school or district entered will be considered a 'team' eligible for this award.

COMPETITION EVENTS

SCORING

Points are awarded based on the final placement in the event. Points are determined by the number of skaters in the Freestyle level, the Dance level, and the number of teams in the Spins/Team Maneuvers Event. Example: If there are 5 skaters/teams - 1st place receives 5 points, 5th place will receive 1 point. If there is only 1 skater/team, 1 point will be awarded. Placements in the spin and maneuver events will be as a team after all 5 elements have been skated and judged in each level. Teams may enter up to 5 skaters in this event.

Skaters may not skate below their USFSA or ISI test level, but may skate one level higher. Freeskate and team events must be skated at the same level.

SOLO DANCE

There will be three levels for this event: Low, Medium and High. Levels are based on current dance test.

Low:

Preliminary - Rhythm Blues
Pre-Bronze - Fiesta Tango
Bronze - Willow Waltz

Medium:

Pre-Silver - European Waltz
Silver - Rocker Foxtrot

High:

Pre-Gold - Kilian
Gold - Argentine Tango

TEAM SPINS AND TEAM MANEUVERS: The spins & maneuvers will be divided in three levels: low, medium, and high. Teams may enter a total of five skaters in spins & a total of five skaters in maneuvers.

SPINS

LOW SPINS (Beginner through Pre-Juvenile)

Two Foot Spin (min 3 revs)
Forward Upright Spin (min 3 revs)
Forward Sit Spin (min 3 revs in position)
Back Scratch Spin (min 3 revs)
Camel Spin (min 3 revs in position)

MEDIUM SPINS (Juvenile and Intermediate)

Layback or Attitude Spin (min 4 revs in position)
Flying Camel Spin (min 5 revs in position)
Front Scratch Spin to Back Scratch Spin (min 4 revs each foot)
Sit Spin to Change Sit Spin (min 4 revs each foot, may begin on front or back foot)
Combo Spin - 1 Change of Foot and at least 1 Change of Position (min 4 revs each foot)

HIGH SPINS (Novice through Senior)

Layback or Crossfoot Spin (min 6 revs in position)
Flying Sit Spin – any flying entry into either a front or back sit spin (min 6 revs in position)
Solo Spin of Choice (min 6 revs)
Combo - Camel/Sit/Change Sit (min 6 revs each foot)
Combo - 1 Change of Foot and at least 2 Changes of Position (min 10 revs total)

MANEUVERS

LOW MANEUVERS (Beginner through Pre-Juvenile)

Waltz Eight (1 Circle on Each Foot)
Flip Jump
Loop Jump
Footwork Followed by a Salchow
Jump Combo - Waltz/Toe Loop

MEDIUM MANEUVERS (Juvenile and Intermediate)

8 Step Mohawk Sequence (either way)
Straight Line Footwork Followed by a Lutz
Jump Combo - Loop/Loop
Flip Jump - Crossovers - Camel Spin
Axel

HIGH MANEUVERS (Novice through Senior)

Bracket Three Bracket Pattern
Straight Line Footwork Followed by a Double or Triple Lutz
Jump Combo - Double/Double or Triple/Double
Double Flip Jump - Crossovers - Camel Spin
Double Axel
