

2012 Showtime On Ice Frequently Asked Questions

What does the staging fee cover?

It helps to cover the cost of the ice for rehearsals and actual shows, the costs of production like stage lighting, props, chair rental, and tickets.

How do we find out about rehearsals and fittings?

When you register your skater for the show, provide an email address. Communication is done through email, so please be sure to keep yours updated with the SOI committee.

Does my skater have to attend all rehearsals?

Rehearsals begin at the end of March, so there are only 4 rehearsals before show week, and attending **ALL** rehearsals is imperative.

How do I purchase tickets?

Tickets will be sold at rehearsals and hopefully online. It is our hope that each participant will sell 10 tickets, allowing the clubs to reach a break-even point. Tickets can be purchased with cash or check; we are working on an option for credit card transactions with a small processing fee applicable.

Will I incur any extra costs besides the staging fee and costume fee?

The only extra cost is for the tickets you purchase. We hold a ticket-selling contest each year, and the top prize is a step-out in the next year's show. Many other donated prizes are awarded to high ticket sellers.

When is the balance of my staging and costume fees due?

All remaining balances need to be paid by February 1, 2012.

Where do I get my skater's costume?

Costume fitting information and other details will be sent by email.

Does the show need parent volunteers?

Yes, YES, and YES!! We will transform the DeLio Rink into a theatre and need **a parent from each family to help**. We also need help to break down the set after the last performance.
