

Denver FSC
Showtime on Ice Assistance Fund Application
Overview

The Denver FSC is pleased to offer a Showtime on Ice Assistance Fund for the purpose of providing financial assistance to dedicated home club members whose families may find their participation in the show a financial burden.

The Denver FSC Board will appoint a small committee of individuals to review applications and determine recipients. The committee will consist of individuals who are actively involved with the skating community, but a) are not the parent of skaters actively participating in programs associated with the Denver FSC, b) are not a coach working with athletes considered to be part of the applicant pool and c) are not in a position of authority with regards to the selection of athletes for, or assignment of roles to the current Showtime on Ice.

All applications will be kept confidential. The Chair of the SOI Assistance Fund Committee will communicate with applicants and report to the Denver FSC Board the number of awards distributed, and their amounts. Grants awarded will be paid directly by the Denver FSC treasurer to Showtime on Ice Treasurer.

CRITERIA TO APPLY and EXPECTATIONS of AWARD RECIPIENTS:

1. Must be a current member in good standing of U.S. Figure Skating, and have been a home club member of the Denver FSC for a minimum of one skating season prior to applying.
2. Must be actively working towards test and/or competition goals in any figure skating discipline.
3. Must have passed a minimum of the Pre-Preliminary Free Skate test.
4. Must be a current elementary, middle or high school student.
5. If selected must commit to being present for all of the mandatory practices / preparations for Showtime on Ice.

Awards will be distributed based on the entry / participation costs of Showtime on Ice, and can be awarded either in full, or a partial amount. Applying is not a guarantee of approval. The amount of the award will not exceed the actual athlete cost to participate. Families with more than one athlete applying must complete a separate application for each athlete.
