



Test Session Covid Protocol for Skaters

- Skaters check in 45 minutes before your scheduled time (test session can run early or behind)
- Skaters are welcome into the lobby 20 min ahead of warm up time or test
 - If the other rink is available, you are welcome to skate/warm up there if you want additional warm up time
- Masks must be worn by all persons, at all times, while in the building
 - Solo skaters may remove masks when they are ON the ice
 - Partnered skaters must wear masks while skating
- Skaters may put their skates on inside the arena, using the designated chairs
- Skaters must exit the building upon conclusion of their test
- All skaters enter the facility through the front doors and exit through the side doors

Test Session Covid Protocol for Spectators*

**** Currently all spectators are restricted from entering South Suburban's facilities**

- ~~Per Tri County Health's recommendation, each skater is only allowed one spectator~~
- ~~Spectators must social distance and masks must be worn at all times when inside the building~~
- ~~The lobby is currently closed – spectators may only watch from stands~~
- ~~No person(s) may linger in the lobby~~
- ~~Spectators must exit the building upon conclusion of the test of their skater~~
- ~~All spectators enter the facility through the front doors and exit through the side doors~~

Test Session Covid Protocol for Judges

- Judges must wear a mask at all times, unless eating, while in the facility
- Judges may spread out on the bench as they prefer. Both benches (home & away boxes) are available should the judge prefer to spread out further. Alternatively, judges may sit in the bleachers if they choose to further spread out.

General - Hospitality Room

- Hospitality will ONLY be for judges
- Food will be individually packaged, when it can be. No community food.
- Each judge will have a designated area in the hospitality room to ensure their own area is kept safe and clean
- Maximum of 6 people in the hospitality room at a time
- Our goal at SSIA will be to have both the hospitality room and adjacent girls locker room to allow for better social distancing
- Masks must be worn in hospitality room unless you are eating or drinking

General - Health

- No person shall enter SSIA if they have a fever over 100.3, have a cough, shortness or breath, sore throat or other similar illness.
- No person shall enter SSIA if, in the prior 14 days, they have had been in contact with someone with COVID-19, they themselves have COVID-19 or they show signs or symptoms of COVID-19
